TOYS

- 1. German Shepherds many times love to play "two ball". Buy two balls with a rope. Then throw one. Coax the pup back with the other ball and when they drop the one in their mouth, throw the second.
- 2. Repeat.
- 3. For prey drive training, to get them to love the moving object/toy, get a stick or plastic PVC about 1 inch thick and maybe 24-28 inches long. Drill a hole on one end. Thread rope or curtain cord through it leaving it about 36-40 inches long. Tie a ball, or canvass bit tube (8x2 inches) to it. Use it to tease the dog and they chase it. Only let them get it once in a while. Quit before they are tired and when they still desperately want it.
- 4. The kong is great. Also puppy nylabone is very good. The rope bones with knots in them are very good, and clean the dog's teeth as they play.
- 5. Pigs ears, rawhide, material toys, tennis balls all not good. Can cause digestive problems and have been known to get dogs ill from bacteria from the plant (some are Mexican which is even more problematic). The glue on tennis balls can erode the enamel on the puppy's teeth.
